Building on the skills and information learned in Project Success, all students reinstated to the University are required to participate in Project Rebound. Illinois State wants to assist you in reaching good academic standing and Project Rebound is designed to help you do just that.

In Project Rebound, you will attend a bi-weekly small group meeting where reinstated students and a success facilitator will develop session topics based on the group's needs.

Your success facilitator will:

- Tailor the meetings to address your unique academic needs and the needs of your group
- Assist in developing and refining academic goals
- Assist with major options for undeclared students
- Motivate to do your best this semester and how to continue that success
- Discuss strategies to help overcome common challenges students face

As a reinstated student, your participation in this program is required.

Requirements for Project Rebound are:

- 1. Register and attend a Project Rebound Orientation.** To register for your orientation, visit forms.illinoisstate.edu/forms/project_rebound_orientation_registration. You are expected to attend the orientation you register for. Your orientation should be scheduled as soon as possible, but no later than August 25.
- 2. Register and attend bi-weekly meetings.** To register for your bi-weekly meetings, visit universitycollege.illinoisstate.edu/projectsuccess/seminar. You are expected to attend each bi-weekly session. Please keep your schedule in mind when registering for your meeting times. Your bi-weekly meeting should be scheduled as soon as possible, but no later than August 29.
- 3. Complete the Project Rebound Survey** at forms.illinoisstate.edu/forms/project_rebound_participant_survey before your first meeting. These responses will be shared with your Academic Advisor and your success facilitator.
- 4. Schedule and attend an advisor conference with your Academic Advisor.** You can find out who your Academic Advisor is by going to your Student Service Center. If you do not have one assigned to you, please call 309-438-7604. Your advisor conference must be completed by October 6.
